

**Call for Applications for Editor
*Public Budgeting & Finance***

Public Financial Publications, Inc., a nonprofit corporation sponsored by the Association for Budgeting and Financial Management and the American Association for Budget and Program Analysis, invites applications for a new editor of its quarterly, peer-reviewed journal, *Public Budgeting & Finance*. We are open to hiring a single editor or team of two editors. The current editors' term ends on December 31, 2023. To facilitate a seamless transition, the new editor will be appointed no later than July 1, 2023, and work alongside the current editorial team for six months before assuming full editorial responsibility of the journal effective January 1, 2024. The term as editor is for three (3) years and may be renewed once.

Public Budgeting & Finance serves as a forum for the publication of research on all facets of government and nonprofit finance. Its purpose is to provide a meaningful dialog among scholars and practitioners in public budgeting and finance. Manuscripts are invited for publication consideration from contributors in universities, private and nonprofit research institutes, public financial markets, and government agencies. *Public Budgeting & Finance* relies on a double-blind review process for publishing understandable, reliable, and thoughtful analyses of critical issues in the field. The content of the journal spans the spectrum of budget processes and policy and financial management. It welcomes contributions that address issues at any level of government, in the nonprofit sector, or internationally. And it welcomes research that is interdisciplinary or cross disciplinary.

The Search Committee seeks an editor with a national reputation as a scholar in public budgeting and finance with a commitment to enhancing scholarly research and encouraging practitioners to share their insights and experiences. Nominations or expressions of interest should be directed to the chair of the search committee. Applications for the position should include a statement of vision and editorial goals for the journal, a letter of institutional support, and a Curriculum Vitae. To receive full consideration, completed applications should be submitted to the chair of the search committee by December 15, 2022.
