In this spirit, PFM seeks scholarly contributions in this line of research inquiry.

We are especially interested in original research manuscripts that explore one or more of the following topics:

- Budgeting Behaviors (Politicians and Bureaucrats)
- Budgeting Mechanisms (Macro and Micro)
- Budgeting Formats
- Budgeting Institutions and Rules (Formal and Informal)
- Emerging Budgeting Practices (e.g., Gender Budgeting, Participatory Budgeting, Green Budgeting)
- International and Comparative Budgeting

The research manuscripts should be submitted by **July 1, 2024**, and comply with PFM's submission guidelines <https://us.sagepub.com/en-us/nam/public-finance-and-management/journal203872#submission-guidelines>. The submitted manuscripts will undergo a rigorous peer-review process. The special issue will appear online or in print as early as Spring 2025.
