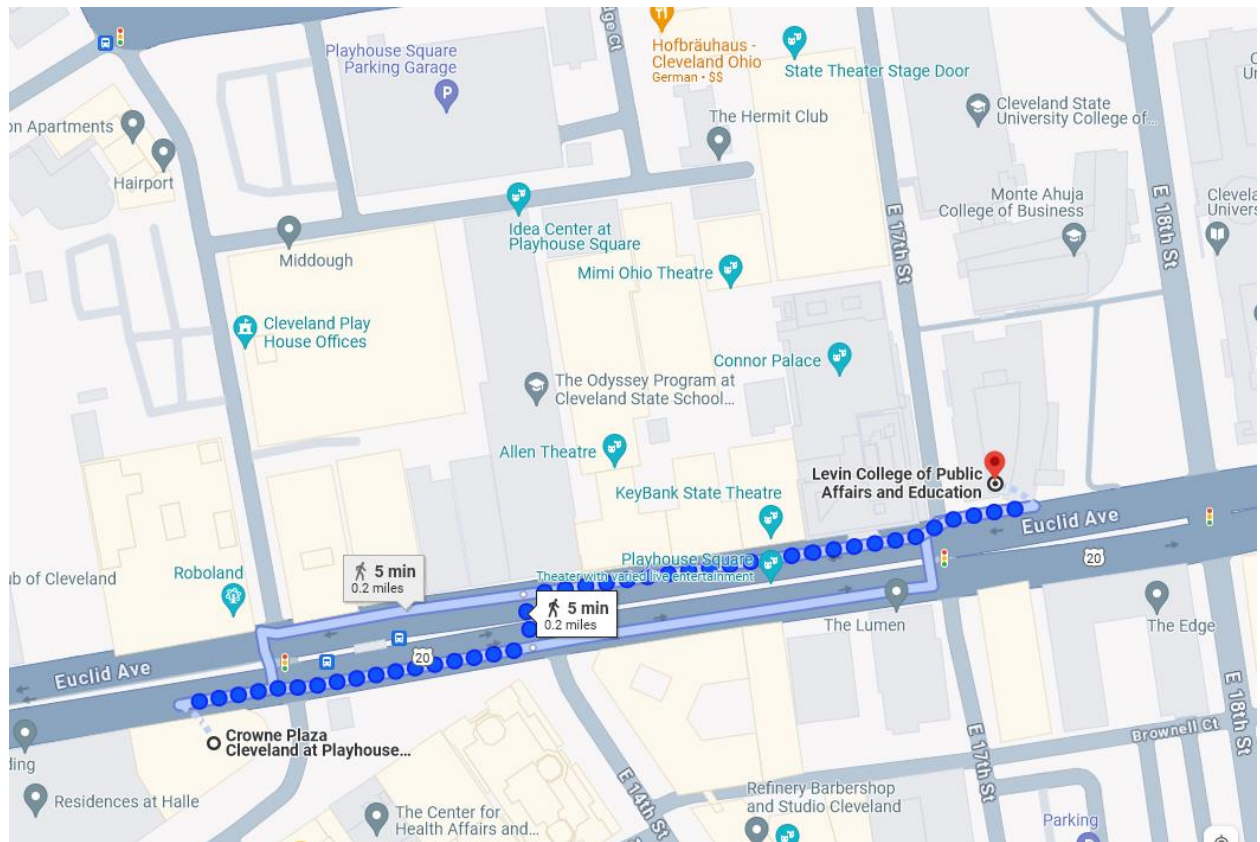

Playhouse Square - 2nd largest theater district in the country

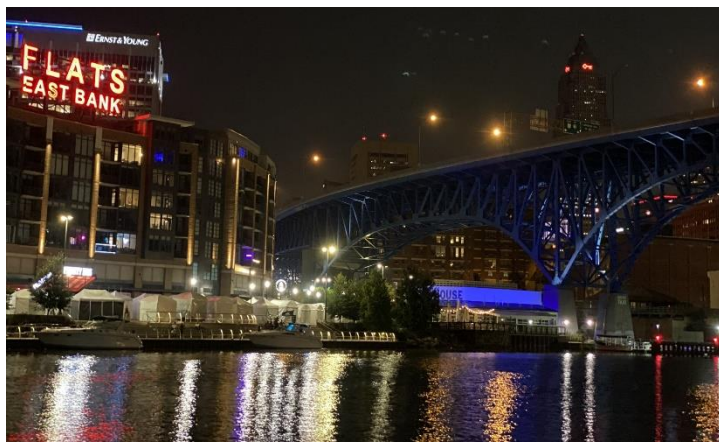
Cleveland Orchestra at Severance Hall

Cleveland Art Museum – ranked number 2 in the nation by Business Insider – **Free** except for special exhibitions

Rock and Roll Hall of Fame (Rock Hall) – the only one in the nation. Building designed by I. M. Pei
