## **ABFM Elected Officials: Executive Committee Members & Vice Chair**

**Nominations due June 27, 2025**

Each year, ABFM holds elections for three new Executive Committee members for three-year terms. As well, the membership elects a Vice Chair who will serve four consecutive years as Vice Chair, Chair-Elect, Chair, and finally Immediate Past Chair. ### **Executive Committee Members**

Members of the ABFM Executive Committee serve three-year terms. While serving on the committee, members are expected to support the organization by actively participating in the organization and committee meetings; serving on standing or ad hoc committees; being an ambassador of ABFM to the professional community; and helping with other duties as needed by ABFM. ### **Vice Chair**

The Vice-Chair elect serves a four-year term, moving sequentially through the roles of Vice-Chair, Chair-Elect, Chair, and finally Immediate Past Chair. The ABFM bylaws ascribes duties to each of the four positions. The main duties include:

- **Vice Chair.** Oversees the site selection for a future conference and part; and participates in committees.
- **Chair-Elect.** Organizes the program for the annual conference; prepares all conference logistics (with the conference host, if there is one); leads budget development for the following year; and participates in a number of committees.
- **Chair.** Oversees the governance of the organization, including seating committees, maintaining the operations, pursuing initiatives, running committee meetings, executing the budget, and chairing or participating in a number of committees.
- **Immediate Past Chair.** Assists officers as they transition into their roles; chairs or participates in a number of committees.

The position requires a significant time commitment and ability to work collaboratively.

### **Nomination Process**

The ABFM membership will vote on the nominees in July. Any ABFM member can nominate themselves or another candidate for an officer position. Each candidate should prepare and submit a statement of no more than 250 words (Executive Committee Member) or 500 words (Vice Chair) of their interest in the position.
